# Safeguarding / Security

## Arrival/Departure

It will be the responsibility of your school to arrange the drop-off and collection of children to and from the event. Upon arrival, every child/school will need to sign in at our welcome desk which will be sign posted.

## Safeguarding

All of our team hold an up-to-date *Enhanced DBS Certificate, Safeguarding Level 2 and Sporting Qualifications*.

In between matches and for children waiting off the pitch as substitutes, it will be the schools' responsibility to ensure the safety of those children.

## Attendees

At least 5 days before the event, we need all the information of the children participating in the event, along with any important medical conditions and/or dietary requirements and allergies they may have.

Online forms will be emailed to you in the 6 weeks leading up to the event.



# Behaviour

- There will be no card system in place for children misbehaving or committing bad fouls, however, our referees will give out warnings and may ask your school teacher to substitute a child for the rest of the match if this persists.
- If a child is too disruptive or is displaying poor behaviour such as bad language, poor sporting behaviour or consistently aggressive play, we will ask for the child to be removed from the match and put on a game suspension until the teacher in charge decides the child can re-join.
- If this happens more than once, our referees will step in and the child will not be able to play for the remainder of the tournament and will stay with the school teacher at the side of the pitches.
- We expect that the referees and coaches from School of Play will be treated with the same respect as the teachers.





# Tournament Rules

- 7 players per team + 5 substitutions.
- Each match will be 10-15 minutes in length (subject to change on the day)
- Each team will play between 4-6 matches.
- There will be no card system in place, but if children demonstrate poor behaviour towards our referees/competitors or continuously commit poor fouls, our referee will ask your teacher to substitute the player after a warning.
- The ball can go above head height but there will be no heading of the football.
- Goalkeepers must roll the ball out of their hands (no kicking).
- The game will be stopped and a free kick awarded to the opposing team in both instances.
- Teams can have as many substitutes during a game as possible.

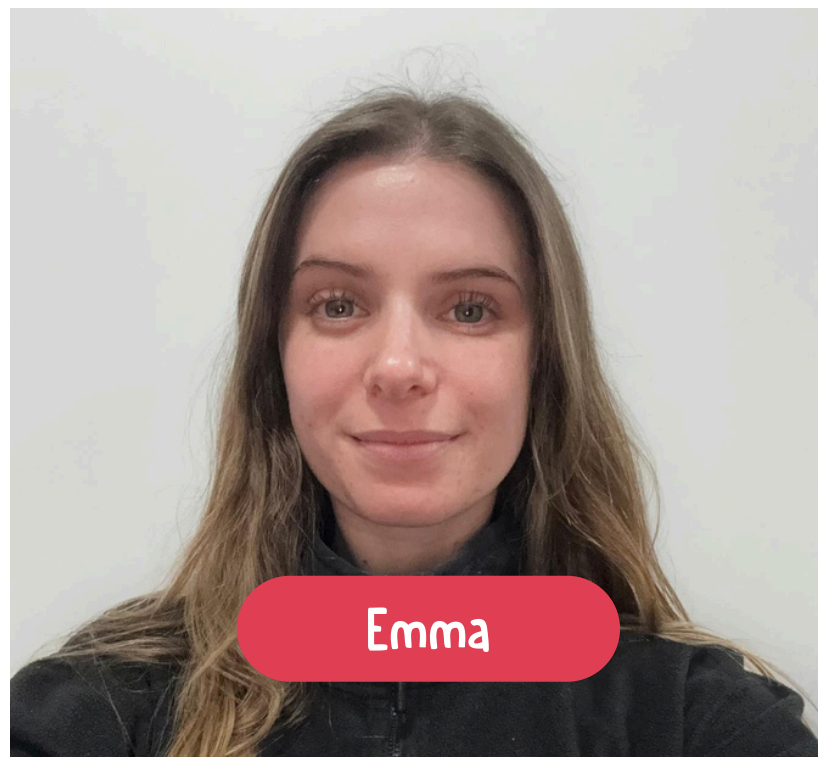
